New Student Financial Aid Check list

In order to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) forms you will need the following documents:

1. CA drivers license or ID card
2. Social Security card
3. If a naturalized citizen or permanent resident – proof of legal status(Elian Card ,
Citizenship Certification or passport)
4. **Documentation of your income for the year 2015.** If you filed taxes - use copies of tax documents. If you did not file taxes - know the amount and source of your income for 2015. (**W-2, AFDC, SSI, Untaxed income**, etc).
5. If you are under age 24, and unmarried, and/or never served in the military, and/or do not have any legal dependents, and/or do not study masters or doctor's programs – you must supply your parent's financial information as well.
6. If you applied financial aid current award year (16-17) before, you must add AEU school code #042271 with your FAFSA.

America Evangelical University does not require copies of these documents with your initial application; however, you will need them to fill out the financial aid paperwork. A minimum of 30% of the applications we submit to the Department of Education for federal grants come back to us with a request for verification. These applications are chosen randomly. If your application is picked to be a part of this sample, you will be required to supply copies of the documents.

Please submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid with www.fafsa.ed.gov as well as you can, prior to your appointment. If you are unable to complete the applications, be sure to bring the appropriate documentation (documents which cover the areas you left blank on the application) to your Financial Aid interview. This will ensure that the applications may be completed at that time.

All financial arrangements should be in place before your orientation.
